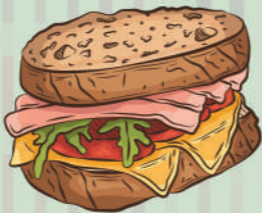

ANSWER: PICTURE 2

The Chinese were taught to use chopsticks long before spoons and forks were invented in Europe (the knife is older, not as an instrument for dining but as a weapon). Some Chinese people were using chopsticks by 1200 BCE. People in the Byzantine Empire used forks for eating by about the 4th century CE. But in western and Northern Europe, there were no forks on the dinner table until some time in the Renaissance.
